The Shearer 2007 Chardonnay

Analysis at Harvest: 23.0 Brix
905 g/l Total Acid
3.25 pH

Analysis at Bottling: 3.35 pH
7.8 g/l Total Acid
13% Alcohol
1.5 g/l Residual Sugar

The Heritage 2007 "Shearer" Chardonnay is produced from selected parcels grown at our Stirling and Glasnevin Vineyards in Waipara, North Canterbury.

The fruit was machine harvested during late April in excellent condition. The fruit was gently pressed then racked to barrel for fermentation and lees ageing. After eleven months the barrels were blended together, lightly fined and filtered prior to bottling.

The Heritage 2007 "Shearer" Chardonnay displays rich, stone fruit aromatics supported by a hint of oak. The palate is fine and elegant with a tight backbone structure and a long finish.

A Chardonnay to enjoy with white meats and seafood over the next 3-5 years
