Nor'wester 2008 Pinot Noir

Analysis at Harvest: 22-23.5 Brix
7.5-9.0 g/l Total Acid
3.30-3.40 pH

Analysis at Bottling: 3.62 pH
5.4 g/l Total Acid
12.5% Alcohol

The Heritage 2008 Pinot Noir is produced from selected parcels grown at our Stirling, Church Road, Georges Road, Glasnevin and Terrace Vineyards in Waipara, North Canterbury.

The fruit was select harvested in excellent condition during April, it was then de-stemmed and tipped into four tonne open top fermenters. Following a 5 day cool soak period, an indigenous fermentation occurred, which lasted for 7 days. After an average of 19 days of stem contact the wine was pressed and then aged for 9 months in barrel prior to blending and bottling.

The Heritage 2008 Pinot Noir displays rich, berry fruit and plum notes with a touch of oak aromatics. It has a full rounded palate with lovely texture and length.

A wine to be enjoyed over the next 3 to 5 years.
